

AVID FRIEND CHIP – MICROCHIP IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Animal Clinic at Thorndale, p.c., offers the AVID microchip identification system to help ensure your pet's proper identification and prompt return to you, should he or she become lost. The microchip is inserted under the skin over the shoulders by a simple injection. There is minimal discomfort with the procedure and it can easily be performed when your pet is in our hospital for a dental cleaning, spay, or neuter procedure. We also can insert the microchip during an outpatient office visit. Our clinic also has the capability of scanning animals for all major microchips used in the United States (including the Isochip). Most animal shelters and many other veterinary hospitals also have the capability of scanning for a microchip should your pet be presented to them. To avoid delays and lost paperwork, we will gladly send in your pet's registration forms for you at the time the chip is inserted. Be certain you complete the owner information on the provided registration form. (If you have a group of up to eight pets with one owner, you may submit your registration directly to Pet Trac for a set group rate.) Pet Trac maintains a computerized database and is backed by the American Veterinary Medical Association. Microchips are the safest and most effective way to permanently identify your pet. It is certainly a small price to pay to ensure the safety of your best friend.
